Will it fit in my door?

The Ultra ES Pro is designed to fit standard travel trailer doors with a lock cut out size of 2-3/4" wide by 3-3/4" tall. Door thickness range is 1-1/2" and 1-3/4".

Is there a left handed version for my entry door?

Yes, there is a left handed version of this lock. The part number is TTLBT-46160LB-2006-1PK.

Do I have to use the app?

The Bluetooth connectivity functions with the Global Link Connect app. However, the lock keypad can be used exclusively for keyless locking and unlocking if desired. The Ultra ES Pro comes with 2 keys that can also be used to operate the lock manually if preferred.

Can it be Keyed ALike?

If you have existing Global locks that have a purple key with a unique key code this lock can be keyed to match. When ordering the Ultra ES Pro through RVLocksAndMore.com make a note in the comments section with the key code you need the lock to match.

What kind of battery does it take?

The Ultra ES Pro uses one C123 Lithium battery. C123 batteries can be found in most convenience/hardware/pharmacy stores. The battery compartment is easily accessible on the backplate of the lock with a phillips screwdriver.

How do I tell if my battery is getting low?

There are two ways to determine the life of your battery. If you have the Global Connect App open, the lock icon directly above the lock/unlock graphic will have a battery life indicator. Also, on the back of the physical lock there is a low battery indicator light. A intermittent flash means the battery is down to around a 20% range.

Does this lock have a deadbolt?

The Ultra ES Pro features a newly integrated deadbolt design. The plunger doubles as a deadbolt when locked by the keypad, app, lower key cylinder, or red deadbolt turn on the backplate. This new design lengthens battery life, and creates less tension and stress on the handles when the travel trailer is not parked and leveled.

What is the difference between the Ultra ES (Bluetooth) and Ultra E (Keyless) entry locks?

The two locks are identical in physical features except for 1 indicator. On the Ultra ES back plate a "Pair" indicator light and reset button is directly below the battery cover.
